**I. OBJECTIVE**

To support and encourage the conservation of natural resources through the efficient use of electrical energy by implementing a rebate incentive for a professional energy audit for La Plata Electric Association's (LPEA) consumers. Such audits will help consumers make informed decisions regarding increasing their homes or business's health, safety and efficiency to save energy and money.

**II. POLICY**

A. Customers within the LPEA service territory are eligible for the Energy Audit Rebate.

B. LPEA customers that have had a professional audit completed and made at least one qualifying energy efficiency upgrade may receive a one-time Energy Audit Rebate. The Rebate shall be no more than \$150 for residential accounts, and no more than \$300 for commercial customers.

C. Total amount of rebates, combined with other entities such as Atmos Energy and City of Durango, cannot exceed cost of the audit.

D. LPEA will develop a list of approved contractors and obtain reports from them on a monthly basis regarding completed audits.

E. To receive proper credit on their account, customers will be required to provide LPEA a copy of the audit report and paid invoice. Energy Management Advisors will compare the receipt to information provided by certified auditors and other local agencies.

F. Members may receive a check or have their account credited.

G. Staff will develop a quarterly report of Energy Efficiency Audit activity.

H. LPEA will sponsor workshops and otherwise inform members regarding the efficient use of energy and available rebates and credits.

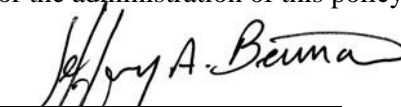
I. This Energy Audit Rebate Policy will be reviewed and revised as necessary and shall include any credits available from Tri-State's programs.
