APPROVAL OF AGENDA

SEPTEMBER FINANCIALS REVIEW

VP Berry gave an overview of the September financials. Most of the board's financial goals were met in September. The cash reserves were approximately \$2.3M below the board's target, this is due to timing variance of cash flow. VP Berry commented that we achieved the target by the time of the meeting looking at our current cash and cash equivalents. VP Berry addressed the Statement of Operations YTD and the current month's budget. VP Berry and EVP Harms answered questions regarding the September financials.

EXECUTIVE SESSION

Committee Chair Wheeler requested a motion to move into an executive session to discuss the capital budget, 2024 rate design review, broadband partnership, and net metering.

and carried without dissent.

The committee remained in the executive session from 9:16 a.m. to 12:11 p.m.

ACTION RESULTING FROM EXECUTIVE SESSION

Motion:

Committee Chair Wheeler moved that the FAC recommend that the board approve the Capital Items and Capital Projects Budgets for the total capital budget that was discussed in the executive session and will be presented to the full board for a total of \$33,403,896 capital budget for 2024. Committee Chair Wheeler then moved that the FAC recommend that LPEA accommodate the Tri-State rate increase in the Operational Budget to pass through the proposed rate increase from Tri-State. The current calculation on the Tri-State 6.2% increase will be a 4% increase on average across our rates. Finally, Committee Chair Wheeler moved that the FAC recommend that the Board utilize any 2023 operating margins above the 2023 operating margin goals to be placed into the reserve fund for the rate stabilization fund. Motion seconded and carried without dissent.
