POWER SUPPLY STRATEGY – President Bassett gave an overview of the three parallel paths to meet LPEA's Strategic Goal, Vision, and Mission Statement as adopted in Resolution 2019-10 LPEA Power Supply Strategy: (1) pursuing more flexibility in the current Tri-State contract; (2) pursuing a partial exit from the current Tri-State contract; (3) and pursuing a full exit from the current Tri-State contract.

VP of Grid Solutions Harms gave a presentation on LPEA's power supply evaluation and proposal for a transitional path forward. Discussion ensued on understanding Tri-State's rate, the general terms of Tri-State's Member Auxiliary Renewable Supply (MARS) partial requirements, a buydown payment calculation for MARS, and Tri-State's partial requirements Open Season (90-day notice, LPEA eligible for 74 MW, recommending 30-50 MW).
